GHOST SHIPS FESTIVAL March 1st & 2nd Manitowoc, WI

This event is now hosted by the Wisconsin Underwater Archeology Association. This year's festival included presentations about four new Great Lakes shipwreck discoveries as well as discussions about shipwreck documentation and underwater exploration technology, lost airplanes on the Lakes and the State and Federal institutions that help to document and tell ithe stories of these important nautical time capsules. There were also exhibitor booths and a chance to view some of the wrecks using 3D photogrammetry technology.

Three of us (Adolph Habich, Joan Chibe, Pam Romund) headed to Manitowoc on Saturday AM. We arrived just a bit after 11. Joan tried the 3D tour of the *Henry Steinbrenner* (ask her about it). We toured the booths and then sat, ready for the lectures:

- Discovery and Documentation of the *Schooner Trinidad* a Case Study in Managing Shipwreck Finds by Brendon Baillod and Robert Jaeck

 invasive species in the Great Lakes and the effect on native species. Look for this one on a streaming
 service soon. It was excellent!
- He Went Down with His Ship: The Discovery of the Steamer Arlington by Dan Fountain
- Award of the Dr. Richard J. Boyd Award for Contributions in Great Lakes Maritime Archeology presented to Brendon Baillod

On the ride home we all agreed it was a very good show and are looking forward to the next festival. IF YOU PLAN TO VOTE BY PROXY

Proxy votes are limited to the election of officers. A full active member may vote a maximum of three (3) proxies. Anyone voting the proxy must also send to the Secretary, Pam Romund (promund@gmail.com), no less than 3 days prior to the election by email from the voting member's email address that is on file with the Club to allow verification of its authenticity by the Secretary.

- i. A proxy is a power of attorney given by one person to another to vote in his stead. The proxy document designates the full Triton member being given the right to vote for the officers and directors, signed by the full member granting the proxy.
- ii. The proxy can be printed or written with signature, a fax copy with signature, or an email copy. A proxy by email to the member voting the proxy must also be sent to the Secretary no less than 3 days prior to the election by email from the voting member's email address that is on file with the Club to allow verification of its authenticity by the Secretary.
- iii. Any proxy sent by email less than 3 days prior to the election can only be accepted by the Club Secretary and must be received no later than 3:00 p.m. local (Central) time on the day of the election, and will be assigned to one of the Board of Directors. These proxies will be assigned in the following order: Second Director, First Director, Secretary, Treasurer, Vice-President and President.

If unusual direct paper secret ballots, a virtual secret ballot is permitted. In virtual secret balloting the identity of the member casting the vote will be known only to the Nominating Committee, who shall guarantee that they will not divulge the content of the virtual ballot.

When voting in ZOOM go to CHAT and then a private CHAT with Margy Levenberg and vote your choice. If you are phoning in to the meeting call Margy at 847-858-1274 with your choice.

RECYCLE YOUR OLD WETSUITS

Over the years, many subscribers have asked us how to recycle their old wetsuits. After all, neoprene is not rubber. It's not biodegradable or compostable. It's a synthetic rubber material formally called polychloroprene, with a landfill life of hundreds of years. Unfortunately, the only guidance we've answered was that all they could do was trash them. There was no commercial recycling. Now comes Lava Rubber (www.lavarubber.com), a forward-thinking company specializing in recycling and transforming materials like old wetsuits into innovative and eco-friendly items like slippers, coasters, and yoga mats. It's joined with Diveheart, a nonprofit organization that provides scuba diving opportunities for people with disabilities, and Scuba.com's two retail outlets (Costa Mesa, CA, and New York City) to collect and recycle unwanted wetsuits. Scuba.com is conducting a promotion with the Beneath the Sea scuba show in Secaucus, New Jersey, March 22-24, a third opportunity to drop off old neoprene. Spend a few bucks – it's worth it given all the enjoyment you've had on pristine reefs – and send your clean, obsolete wetsuit or drysuit to Lava Rubber, Attn: Upcycle, 151 Industrial Way E #A1, Eatontown, NJ 07724
