ST. CROIX ADVENTURE



On April 21st a band of intrepid Tritons flew out of O'Hare headed to St. Croix in the USVI. Our group consisted of 13 in total of which 9 were divers and the others of course non-divers. We arrived in St. Croix early afternoon and after collecting our luggage and our Ford 15 passenger van we set out for the resort. Our retreat for this trip was The Cottages by the Sea in Frederiksted on the west coast of the island. Each cottage is uniquely different and made for an interesting stay. Our dive shop

partner was Cane Bay Divers located about 10 minutes away in Frederiksted.

The diving was outstanding and we met the dive boat either at the pier in Frederiksted or at the marina at Salt River on the north coast of the island. Getting to the northern dockage only took about 20-25 minutes but was made a bit interesting by the fact that they drive on the left side of the road in St. Croix. As the designated driver, the group had to put a whole lot of faith in my boast that I could handle this with no problem. Also, almost all of the vehicles on the island are left hand drive so that makes it even more interesting.

Anyway, we found some great local restaurants for dinner and on the last day were able to take a sightseeing drive around the island. The Diving:

Everyone, Divers and Non-Divers, will have to sign a Liability Release. The forms are available on Pearl Lake's web site:

The forms are online. Pearl Lake prefers that we submit them online.

From the landing page above, scroll down until you see:

Electronic Waivers & Documents: See below:

- 1. INDIVIDUAL DIVER WAIVER** Everyone who is diving must complete this form
- 3. NON-DIVER GUEST WAIVER** Everyone who is not diving must complete this form.
- 5. DIVE SITE MAP & 7. PEARL LAKE DIVING BROCHURE** Optional – a full-page dive site map, and an informative brochure about Pearl Lake.

The Waiver process requires that you include your email address. The system will send you an email to confirm your email address. Once you do, another email will confirm that you have completed the process, and will include a link to download the document. Please download and print a copy, and bring it when you check in at the Lake.

When you arrive at the Lake, go to registration and sign in. You must bring your C Card, and a copy of the release. **The cost will be \$30 for divers and \$25 for non-divers – If you are not diving you must tell them that.** Cash, debit or credit card only. No checks.

Rose and I will arrive early and find a site. Look for the Triton's Signs.

The Eating:

We will have hot dogs, hamburgers, sausages, potato salad, coleslaw and chips. A dish to pass is always welcome, especially if it's chocolate. ☺

This is the first notice that next year's dive trip will be to Little Cayman. We haven't been here since 2018. Here are the details.

Dates: April 24 - May1, 2027.

Resort: Little Cayman Beach Resort – Pool View rooms

Cost per diver: \$2895.00 Double Occupancy (Non-diver is \$400.00 less)
\$3619.00 Single Occupancy (Non-diver is \$400.00 less)

Package Includes: 7 night's accommodations
Breakfast, lunch and dinner daily (dinner on day of arrival breakfast on day of departure)] are not included)

Air arrangements are not included. You will need to do your own air. I will be looking at schedules and will let you know what looks to be the best schedules.

A deposit of \$50.00/person will hold your spot. Deposit and final payment will need to be made by check or Zelle. Final payment will be due approximately 45 days before arrival in Little Cayman.
